Licencing for Competitive Fishing Events

A Competitive Fishing Event is defined as an event scheduled for up to 2 or more days at a specified water body that has 26 or more participants competing with hook and line for prizes awarded on the basis of fish size or weight.

Competitive fishing event licences will only be issued to an adult resident of Alberta or to an organization, club, social group or business incorporated or registered under the *Business Corporations Act* or *Societies Act*. Once all information is provided please allow 15 business days for application processing.
